THE GVTAA OUTSTANDING VETERINARY ASSISTANT AWARD

About the Award:

Each year the award shall be given to recognize the Veterinary Assistant who, in the judgment of fellow peers, has significantly contributed to the profession of Veterinary Assisting in the state of Georgia. The award will consist of an award plaque with the presentation being made at the Annual GVTAA Fall Conference. Honorees will also be highlighted in the quarterly newsletters and on the GVTAA website for the year following presentation.

Nominees will be selected from submitted applicants. The committee of judges will consist of the current GVTAA Executive Board.

Criteria for award evaluation:

- 1) GVTAA MEMBERSHIP – for the year of nomination
- 2) Professional experience
- 3) State and local animal care activities
- 4) Contributions to the advancement of Veterinary Assistants
- 5) Published materials, project presentations and awards
- 6) At *least* two letters of recommendation to accompany nomination

The individual submitting the nomination should include a summary of why they feel this individual should receive the recognition award. This summary would accompany the entry information sent to the Executive Board.
